We have been praying and seeking God to give us vision and direction for the next 2 years at Connect Church. I feel that God is leading us back to Acts Chapter 1, where the church began. WHERE We've BEEN...

Connect Church launched on Easter Sunday of 2015 at Uthoff Valley Elementary School. Connect continued to see growth in our worship services, averaging around 300 in attendance.

Connect purchased our building and completely renovated it.

Added a second service with around 200 attending for worship and saw around 40 baptisms.

Added a 3rd service at the beginning of 2019 and saw over 50 baptized. Connect celebrated 90 baptisms and broke ground in March 2022 on our new Worship Center, Lobby, and restrooms. We held our first services in the new building on Christmas Eve with around 600 in attendance.

God continued to bless despite COVID. We went ALL IN as a church family in order to expand our building.

Completed construction on the new Pre-K wing as well as transformation of the gym into the Next Gen Zone.

Added Women's Ministry and expanded Small Group offerings with record attendance.
